

The following is the constitution of the “Seadeucers at UCSD:”

I. Organization Name

- a. The organization will be officially known as the “Seadeucers”.

II. Statement of Purpose

- a. This organization, a not-for-profit organization, maintains the expressed goals of organizing UCSD students, faculty, and staff who are interested in SCUBA diving into a coherent group which acts as a forum for discussions of SCUBA diving and important issues concerning the ocean environment, and introduces new people to SCUBA diving and the possibilities offered by the local ocean environment through educational programs and speakers.
- b. The Seadeucers will not participate in any SCUBA diving activities, defined as any activity in which one submerge themselves more than five feet below the surface using SCUBA equipment, on UCSD property.

III. Membership Requirements

- a. Membership is open to all UCSD affiliates.
- b. Members should have an interest in SCUBA diving, but experience is not required.
- c. Per UCSD regulations, the club will maintain a 75% undergraduate membership.

IV. Meetings

- a. Meetings will be held once a month on the second Wednesday of the month.
- b. A guest speaker will be present at all meetings to give a presentation.

V. Offices and Officers

a. Offices

- i. The primary officers are as follows: President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Guest Speaker Coordinator.

b. Responsibilities

- i. The President is responsible for coordinating all club activities and overseeing all operations of the club.
- ii. The Vice President is responsible for running meetings in the absence of the president and completing all tasks assigned to him/her by the president.
- iii. The Treasurer is responsible for requesting money from the AS council and providing compensation to guest speakers as negotiated.
- iv. The Guest Speaker Coordinator is responsible for scheduling guest speakers to speak on topics relating specifically SCUBA diving. They may also speak about ocean issues in relation to SCUBA activities.

c. Miscellaneous

- i. All officers will sign as principle members.
- ii. The officers will be UCSD undergraduate students.

d. Officer Selection

- i. Primary officers are voted by a simple majority of members present at the time of the election.
- ii. Elections will be held the last meeting before finals of spring quarter.
- iii. New officers will assume office at the beginning of the following academic year.
- iv. The term of office is one full year, including summer.
- v. No nominations are necessary to run for office.
- vi. Event Leaders are appointed by the primary officers.
